

Dr. Ahmed to Head Psychiatric Services

Mohammed B. Ahmed, M.D., will assume the position of John Peter Smith Hospital Director of Psychiatric Services in August.

Dr. Ahmed, presently professor of psychiatry at Wright State University in Dayton, Ohio, will be directly involved with in-patient psychiatric care as well as staff supervision. He also will serve in a teaching capacity to resident M.D.'s on psychiatric rotation at the Hospital, constructing learning activities and traditional classroom and conference situations.

With a medical degree from Karachi University in Pakistan, Dr. Ahmed completed residencies in psychiatry in Glasgow, Scotland. He is a diplomate in psychiatry (D. P. M.) in the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons at London, England, Edinburgh and Glasgow, Scotland and Canada (F. R. C. P.).

His professional experience includes positions as clinical director at the St. Louis State Hospital Complex in St. Louis, Missouri, and director of the department of psychiatry at County General Hospital in Clayton, Missouri. He was attending psychiatrist at Bronx Municipal Hospital in Bronx, New York, visiting psychiatrist at the Hospital of Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Bronx, New York and director of the Sound View-Throgs Neck Community Mental Health Center, Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Bronx, New York.

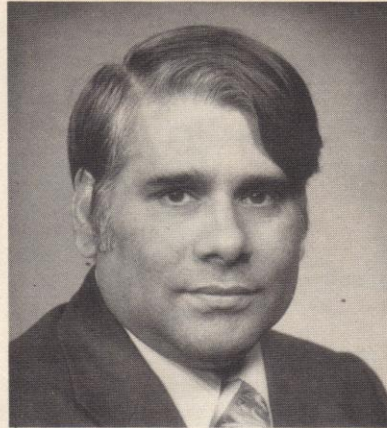
A Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association, Dr. Ahmed did postdoctoral training at Jinah Post-Graduate Medical Center in Karachi, Pakistan; the Shotley Bridge General Hospital and Hemlington Hospital at Durham and Middlesborough, England, respectively. He also trained at Glasgow University Southern General Hospital and the Eastern District Hospital, both in Glasgow, Scotland, and Preston Hospital in Northshire, England.

With professional memberships and honors in more than twenty medical councils, societies and associations world-wide, Dr. Ahmed was named to "Who's Who in the East" in 1977-78 and has received the Physician's Recognition Award, American Medical Association, three consecutive times, 1971-74, 1974-77 and 1977-80.

More than twelve of his works are published in various forms, with some thirteen others now pending publication or in the working stage.

Dr. Ahmed joins John Peter Smith as successor to Dr. David R. Baker, who was director of psychiatric services from 1973 through January of 1977.

An American citizen, Dr. Ahmed, 43, was born in Hyderabad, India. He and his wife have two children.
